Eligible Candidates: Professionals who work outside formal classroom setting.

AWARD PURPOSE: To recognize and honor individuals whose work takes place outside of the formal classroom, but have made outstanding contributions to support geography education or geography educators.

ELIGIBILITY:

- a. Nominator must be a current NCGE member.
- b. Individuals who work outside the formal classroom (e.g. government, policymakers, school board, professional development providers, publishers, curriculum developers, etc.) are eligible to receive this award.
- c. Nominators, references, and application documents must address several elements of outstanding support as described in the documentation requirements, listed on page 2.
- d. The nominator must submit all required information in one file via email to awards@ncge.org by the deadline.

Please note: Incomplete applications or applications received after deadline will not be considered.

AWARDS CEREMONY: Higher Education Distinguished Teacher awardees will be recognized at the 2019 National Conference on Geography Education, November 22-24, 2019 in Austin, Texas.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OUTSTANDING SUPPORT FOR GEOGRAPHY EDUCATION AWARD

The nominator must submit all of the required information listed below. **Self-nomination is permitted.** The nominator must be a current NCGE member. Application information should be compiled into one file and emailed to awards@ncge.org. Letters should be sent electronically but may be sent separately to awards@ncge.org.

Endorsement letters – Maximum of three (3) letters from colleagues

Application Information

1. Biodata sheet providing the following information:
 - a. Name
 - b. Title and employer
 - c. Work address/telephone number/email
 - d. Degrees held (sources and dates)
2. Please answer the following question (1 page): What has been the nominee's major contribution or impact on geographic education?
3. List any published teaching/geographic education-related materials the nominee has authored, co-authored, or committee- authored.
