

ANNOUNCEMENT: Funding for AP Human Geography Sessions at the Puerto Rico Conference

There is limited funding available for Advanced Placement Human Geography (APHG) teachers planning to present papers at the National Conference on Geography Education in Puerto Rico and for AP teachers who plan to teach the course beginning fall 2009 or who taught the course for the first time in 2008–09. Proposed sessions will be included in the APHG workshop. Funded teachers will be required to attend the APHG workshop sessions on Friday morning (September 25), the fieldwork session planned for Friday afternoon, and workshop sessions scheduled throughout the day on Saturday (September 26). Continuing education certificates will be provided. Requests for funding must include the items listed below.

- Cover sheet with your name, school, preferred mailing address, e-mail address, and title of the proposed session (if applicable)
- One-page description (250-word maximum) of your proposed session OR a one-page narrative showing how your participation in the APHG workshop will increase your effectiveness in the classroom
- One-page budget of expenses, including opportunities for alternate or matching funding

Your name or other identifying information should appear only on the cover sheet. All applications will be considered. It is not necessary to present a paper in a session in 2009, but we do hope that those receiving funding will consider submitting a proposal for the 2010 National Conference on Geography Education in Savannah, Georgia.

Requests for funding will be evaluated by the APHG workshop organizer and three other geographers involved with APHG. Mail funding requests to:
